1. Hearing Petition: Over-Order Premium beginning October 1, 2018, for All Milk Marketing Areas.

6. REPORT OF CHIEF COUNSEL:

PRESENTED by: Attorney Eberly

DISCUSSION: Attorney Eberly stated that he met with the Board and Secretary Moyer in the morning prior to the hearing, to review the general regulatory review procedure. The Board had lunch together and no deliberations nor official actions were taken. Following the meeting the Board will gather privately to get to know one another, without him nor Secretary Moyer, and no official actions will be taken.

7. **LEGAL CASE DISPOSITIONS**

1. NFO Inc. Late Dealer Monthly Reports

PRESENTED by: Attorney Saylor

DISCUSSION: Attorney Saylor stated when there is a violation there will be a citation issued and they have the option to meet with the board or pay the penalty. He presented **1. Legal Docket CA-18-008 for NFO Inc.** for late dealer monthly reports. A consent order was signed and a penalty of \$100.00 was paid subject to Board approval.

8. LICENSE APPLICATIONS:

1. HP Hood LLC Batavia Dealer

PRESENTED by: Attorney Saylor

DISCUSSION: Attorney Saylor presented that HP Hood LLC Batavia has submitted an application for a dealer license, for 2018-2019, this is a new plant which is not operational yet but will be soon. Applicant will purchase milk from a cooperative, and bulk milk from an undetermined dealer. Applicant will process and package milk/cream products for resale in all six Areas in PA. No bond is required at this time but will be monitored to see if one is needed when they are in operation. Appropriate staff has reviewed the application to ensure that all forms have been received and are in order, and that the applicant has met the requirements of the Milk Marketing Law. A Provisional license was granted on June 22, 2018. With Board approval of this application, a dealer license will be issued.

Moved to approve a dealer license to HP Hood LLC Batavia as presented. **Seconded by Consumer Member Hardbarger**

DISCUSSION: Member Van Blarcom inquired if they will need a bond. Attorney Saylor stated that it will be monitored until we know their milk source, to determine the bond requirement. There is an existing large bond in place for their other plants.

2. Corey Lewis D/B/A Core Dairy

Subdealer

PRESENTED by: Attorney Saylor

DISCUSSION: Attorney Saylor presented that Corey Lewis D/B/A Core Dairy has submitted an application for a subdealer license, for 2018-2019. Applicant will purchase packaged milk from an instate dealer. Applicant will sell to restaurants, schools, and stores in Area 3. A bond has been provided. Appropriate staff has reviewed the application to ensure that all forms have been received and are in order, and that the applicant has met the requirements of the Milk Marketing Law. A Provisional license was granted on June 19, 2018. With Board approval of this application, a subdealer license will be issued.

Moved to approve a subdealer license to Core Lewis D/B/A Core Dairy as presented. **Seconded by Member Van Blarcom. Motion carried without dissent.**

3. Rainforest Distribution Corp.

Subdealer

PRESENTED by: Attorney Saylor

DISCUSSION: Attorney Saylor presented that Rainforest Distribution Corp. has submitted an application for a subdealer license, for 2018/2019. Applicant will purchase packaged milk from an instate dealer. Applicant will sell packaged products to restaurants and stores in all six Areas. A COD letter has been provided in lieu of a bond. Appropriate staff has reviewed the application to ensure that all forms have been received and are in order, and that the applicant has met the requirements of the Milk Marketing Law. A Provisional license was granted on June 4, 2018. With Board approval of this application, a subdealer license will be issued.

Moved to approve a subdealer license to Rainforest Distribution Corp. as presented. **Seconded by Consumer Member Hardbarger.**

DISCUSSION: Member Van Blarcom inquired that with the COD, it means Cash on Delivery and the liability would fall back to the dealer. Member Van Blarcom asked how COD works in these situations. Attorney Saylor stated that COD is not defined in the regulations, we have a guideline of a few days and the responsibility does fall between the two parties and releases the Milk Marketing Board.

4. Kings Kreamery LLC Producer COD

PRESENTED by: Attorney Saylor

DISCUSSION: Attorney Saylor presented the Kings Kreamery LLC license renewal. The Milk Producers' Security Act allows for an arrangement between a producer and the dealer, to have a COD in place of a bond. This is very infrequent. It is a situation where it is usually a small business with a trust relationship between dealer and producer. In this case Kings Kreamery LLC is buying from 2 producers, who are part owners, but still require a bond or COD arrangement. They have agreed in writing to the arrangement, in lieu of a bond. If they were to buy milk from anyone else they would need a COD arrangement, and ask for the Board's approval, or provide a bond.

MOTION by: Consumer Member Hardbarger

Moved to approve the Producer COD arrangement with Kings Kreamery LLC as presented. **Seconded by Member Van Blarcom. Motion carried without dissent.**
